- **Letter of Interest** (1 page double spaced) - indicate your topics of interest. Explain why you are interested in the internship. Include your future career goals.
- **1-2 drawing samples** (preferably related to contemporary affairs)
- **Your general availability** for the Fall Quarter (Monday - Friday, 9AM - 9PM)
